Chelsea Penthouse Manhattan, New York

This custom Robert Siegel-designed 2,900-square-foot, three-bedroom penthouse is perched atop a prewar loft building in the heart of Chelsea. The expansive living room has 12-foot ceilings, and features multiple over-size windows providing abundant light. The media room features a surround-sound system with a 50-inch plasma TV and a gas fireplace. A glass stairway leads to the rooftop terrace with a trellised St. Tropez-style dining gazebo and covered lounge area with a waterfall, landscaping, custom lighting and fully equipped outdoor kitchen. The second terrace level features an eight-person Arctic Spa with panoramic views. The spacious kitchen features cherry cabinetry, stainless appliances and a built-in breakfast area. A 600-bottle wine cellar is concealed behind automated Makore wood panels. A 250-gallon aquarium separates the living room from a home office/third bedroom. The home has two and a half baths; the master suite features an ensuite spa-bathroom, with a dual-sided fireplace and a deep freestanding soaking tub.
