

Flying low

IT seems a tad below his price point, but Oscar nominee **Leonardo DiCaprio** — Winslet's co-star in "Titanic" — recently toured a two-bedroom apartment in the Village with a \$1.56 million asking price.

Our surprised spies reported seeing the "Aviator" star and his supermodel squeeze, **Gisele Bundchen**, perusing the prewar co-op at 1 Fifth Ave.

According to the listing, the 1,350-square-foot apartment is on a high floor in a prime corner of the landmarked building.

Not that \$1.5 million is cheap. But DiCaprio's income, exclusive of Bundchen's mega-salary, is more than \$20 million a film, plus royalties. (He actually turned a \$2.5 million salary into a \$50 million bonanza just on "Titanic.")

"Maybe he was looking to buy it for a family member," theorized our source.
